THE SERIOUS STUFF

- To use the E-File on a client, you must be E-File trained.
- If you/your client has diabetes or any other health concern, please consult with a GP before using the E-File.
- You may apply the instructions below to any relevant manicure treatment, as per your preference.
- The E-File must not come in contact with water at any time.
- The E-File should be used on dry skin, and proper care should be taken to avoid any contact between water and the machine or its cords and outlets.

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STEP-BY-STEP

1. Sanitise hands.
2. Ensure the client's skin and nails are completely dry.
3. Make sure your selected E-File bits are sanitised. When ready to use, insert the E-File bit into the handpiece and ensure the chuck is locked.
4. Select the correct direction for your machine depending on your dominant hand. Right-handed technicians should use the E-File in the forward/clockwise motion. Left-handed technicians should use the E-File in the reverse/anti-clockwise motion.
5. Turn your machine's RPM to the correct speed for your E-File bit.
6. When you are finished using your E-File bit, unlock the E-File chuck and place your e-file bit to the side to be sanitised.
7. Dust any excess cuticle/dead skin away using TGB's Dusting Brush.
8. To ensure no dust collects in the e-file handpiece while not in use, insert your E-File safety and lock in place.
9. Turn off and unplug your E-File while not in use.
